

## CODA, Pano and Sirio Shower Sets and Hand pieces

### CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Cleaning with a mild detergent and soft cloth only is recommended.

Avoid harsh abrasives, steel wool and hard-bristled brushes.

Mineral deposits and contaminants may buildup in the nozzles, showerhead and generally around the edges of the shower head. This may affect the flowrate and shower pressure.

It is recommended that you clean the shower head thoroughly at least every other month. Where the water is harder, it may be necessary to clean more frequently than that.

Soaking the shower head in vinegar (or lemon juice and water) for several hours is recommended for moderate build ups. Alternatively use a domestic mineral cleaner such as CLR (Calcium Lime Rust Remover) and use as per the manufacturer's directions.

Rinse clean then polish off with a soft microfibre cloth to prevent spotting.
